

# SP8603 Wind Jammer

For caravans with wind affected Heki rooflights



Stop the wind blowing the rooflight wide open



Some HEKI rooflights are prone to being blow open when the wind is strong and from the wrong direction. The Windjammer cures this problem.

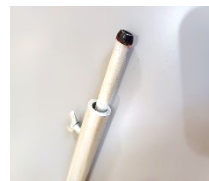


Decide where you want to limit the movement of the rooflight bar.

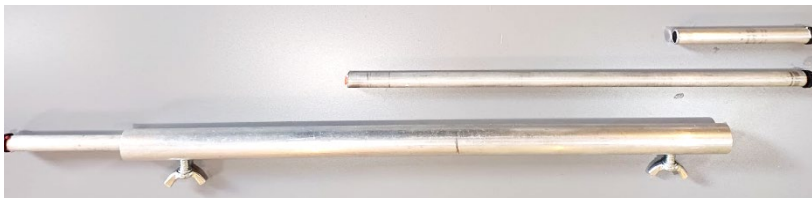
Expand the windjammer so that it fits into the grooves on both sides in the chosen position. Tighten the butterfly screws to fix the length, so that the Windjammer stays firmly in place



When the rooflight is closed, the Windjammer stores neatly within the rooflight frame



Detail of one end, showing the outer tube, one inner tube and the securing butterfly screw



There are two inner expander tubes to cater for different sizes of rooflights. The short tube, paired with one longer tube, is for small rooflights; the two longer tubes, paired, cater for larger rooflights.
